In loving memory of Robin Shawlinski. A TRUE WARRIOR and one of the strongest women I have ever known.

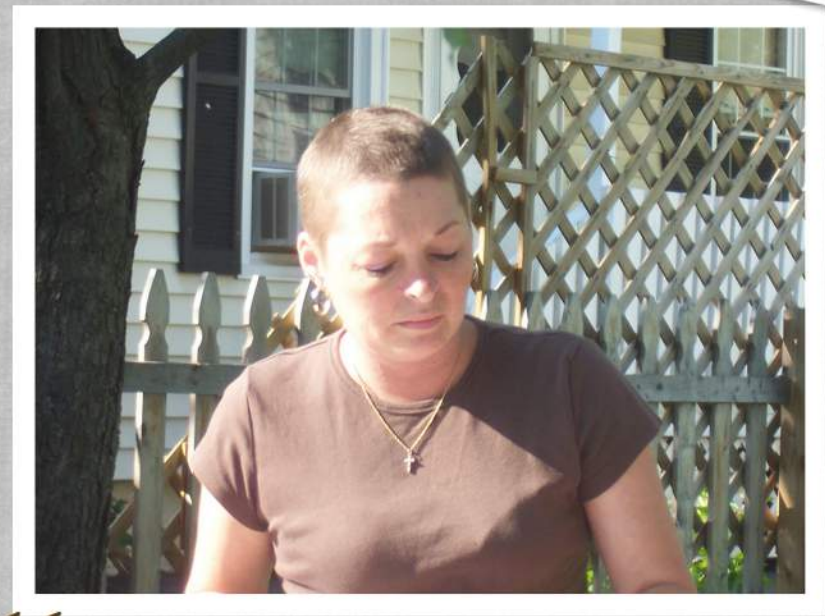
