On 27 Sep 1904 after the announcement of 3 banns on the 11th, 18th and 25th of September at parish masses and no impediment being found, I Fr Lacouture questioned Joseph A. Poissant age 23, son of Napoleon Poissant and Esther Sorel of N. Adams, MA, and living in Burlington; and Octavie Dore, age 21, daughter of Leandre Dore and Octavie St Amour, in their presence verbally obtained their mutual consent, performed the marriage nuptials in the presence of Leandre Dore and Vitalien Poissant.
